CSUF PD seeks to distinguish itself by seizing opportunities to respond and serve our University Community. This is accomplished through a sincere interest in meeting the needs of our customers, and swift response to their concerns. Below are some safety tips to consider when around campus.

- Don't be an easy victim, project the right body language at all times.
- Always be alert and aware of your surroundings.
- Do not be easily distracted or take your eyes off of some one you feel maybe suspicious in a possibly dangerous situation.
- The blue emergency phones around campus will get you a dispatcher on the line by the push of a button.
- If you feel unsafe call dispatch for an escort.
- Always carry ID and enough cash in case you need to take a taxi.
- Avoid dangerous places at night.
- Do not leave your personal property unattended while on campus, especially in the Library.
- Use a U-Lock to lock up your bike.
- Do not give out your personal information to strangers, you may become a victim of Identity Theft.
- If you dial 9-1-1 from campus you will get a University PD dispatcher.
- If you feel you are in a potentially dangerous situation, leave the scene and call police.

ConnectEd is a service that allows the campus to send emergency or other important messages to all students, faculty and staff via their email, home, campus office and cellular phones. All contact information is obtained through campus databases, except cellular phone numbers. The information must be personally entered by each person at: <https://myweb.fullerton.edu/phoneupdate>. Any changes to cell phone numbers are made at this site as well.
