Campus Safety

It is important for CSUF students to know the safety precautions, rules, and regulations on campus. We are dedicated to ensuring the University Community's right to a crime free environment through exemplary and professional service. We are physically located at the corner of State College Blvd and Gym Dr.

- 25 sworn Police Officers
- Police Patrol campus and the surrounding community 24 hours every day of the year
- Community Service Officers
- 164 Emergency Blue Phone located around campus
- E-911 service: 911 calls made from your cell phone nearby the campus – goes directly to our Police dispatch

Personal Safety

- Take a self defense class
- Report any suspicious activities immediately to the University Police
- File a police report promptly if you are a victim of a crime

Vehicle Safety

- Park in well lit areas
- Lock all doors and roll-up windows
- Activate car alarms and use any anti-theft devices
- Walk to car with keys in hand
- Do not store valuables in car or keep them out of plain sight
- Do not store car title papers inside car

Student Conduct

The University is committed to maintaining a safe and healthy living and learning environment for students, faculty, and staff. Per 41301 - Standards for student conduct, Title 5 of the California Code Of Regulations:

- Students may be held accountable for your conduct on and off campus.
- Students may be sent to judicial affairs for student discipline.
- Administrative disciplinary sanctions imposed on violators can include Academic probation, expulsion from CSUF and/or all CSU campuses.

Theft on Campus

The #1 crime on the CSU Fullerton campus is theft of personal and state property. The majority of thefts that occur on campus are “thefts of opportunity.”

- Do not leave personal belonging unattended
- Do not trust stranger to watch your personal belongings
- Record the make, model, and serial numbers for electronics

Walking at Night

- Avoid walking alone at night
- Utilize Police Escort Service – call (657) 278-2515
- Avoid dark and remote areas
- Avoid distractions such as texting or listening to music
- Take cell phone with you
- Be familiar with your surroundings and landmarks on campus.
- Keep hands free from bulk items

Date Safety

- Take time getting to know new companions
- Stay with your friends or large groups, do not get isolated with companion
- Tell a trusted friend your dates full name, your destination and your expected time back
- No means NO
- Do not accept already opened drinks from strangers
- Do not leave your drinks unattended
- Take cell phone with you
- Avoid excessive alcohol consumptions
- Have a back-up plan(ride, money, cab)



Dorm Safety

- Lock all windows and doors
- Do not loan out your apartment keys
- Avoid hosting parties where strangers might attend
- Communicate your schedule with your roommate
- Provide your roommates with your family's contact information for emergencies
- Never Leave doors unlocked when not at your apartment
