Student Stabbed

On Wednesday, October 31, 2018, at about 1pm, Fullerton Police Department received a call that a CSUF student was reportedly stabbed in the parking structure located at the Evangelical Free Church in the city of Fullerton. CSUF Police Officers arrived and assisted Fullerton PD with the search of the possible suspect. The victim received several wounds to both hands.

The suspect is described as: Thin, about 6'0" tall; black shorts and shirt; long, dark, curly hair with white streaks. Suspect allegedly fled on foot in a Southwest direction from the parking structure. Fullerton Police Department is the handling agency for this incident.
