CSUF Police Department Launches Titan Safety E-Scooter Safety Lab

Fullerton, CA (April 23, 2026) – The CSUF Police Department is proud to announce its partnership with [Hiboy](#) and [Lumos](#) helmets for the launch of the Titan Safety E-Scooter Lab, an innovative initiative aimed at promoting safe, responsible, and informed use of e-scooters.

The Titan Safety E-Scooter Lab will take place on April 29th from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. in the CSUF Central Quad, with a raffle to follow. The event brings together industry leaders and campus safety professionals to educate the Titan community on responsible e-scooter use. During the lab, participants will complete a guided obstacle course designed to simulate real-life riding scenarios. CSUF Police personnel will provide step-by-step instructions and supervision, helping riders build confidence and improve their ability to safely navigate common hazards. The course reinforces essential techniques, including controlled braking, maneuvering, and situational awareness.

“Our goal is to help students stay safe and thrive by encouraging responsible riding, awareness of their surroundings, and compliance with university regulations,” said Anthony Frisbee, CSUF Police Chief.

Immediately following the lab at 1 p.m., Hiboy and Lumos will sponsor a raffle for participants who completed the course. All eligible participants have the opportunity to win e-scooters, helmets, and other prizes. Must be present at the time of the drawing to claim a prize.

“At CSUF Police Department, we strive to prioritize the safety of our students. This collaboration with Hiboy allows us to educate the campus community on the rules of the road and ensure proper safety equipment is worn,” said Detective Adam Kashe.

The CSUF Police Department has observed an increase in e-scooter use in recent years, accompanied by concerns of collisions, improper riding behavior, and pedestrian safety. This initiative reflects the department’s ongoing commitment to proactive community engagement and innovative approaches to public safety.
