CSUF Police Department Receives National Accreditation

Fullerton, CA (July 29, 2026) - The CSUF Police Department has earned accreditation from the International Association of Campus Law Enforcement Administrators (IACLEA), placing the department in the top 10% of university police departments nationwide and among only six California State police departments to earn this accreditation. IACLEA accreditation acts as a benchmark for excellence, demonstrating that the department upholds the highest standards of practice by meeting 227 additional IACLEA accreditation standards beyond those required by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST).

In April, the CSUF Police Department hosted a team of assessors from IACLEA, who reviewed their policies, procedures, management, support services, and operations to ensure compliance with IACLEA's nationally recognized standards for campus law enforcement agencies. During the assessment, members of the community and the public were invited to provide feedback on the department via telephone as a part of the assessment process. The final accreditation was granted in June.

"Accreditation reinforces that campus safety is a shared responsibility and reflects our promise to continually enhance the services we provide in partnership with students, staff, faculty, and visitors at Cal State Fullerton," said Jeniffer Rollins, accreditation manager.

"I am proud of the CSUF PD team for demonstrating our unwavering commitment to serving the Titan community with integrity, professionalism, and care," said Anthony Frisbee, chief of police. "In addition, I am glad our department's holistic, tiered response model has received recognition."

The accreditation is valid for four years, during which time, the police department will submit annual reports to IACLEA demonstrating its continued compliance with the standards under which it was accredited. As a part of these reports, the department will benefit from increased accountability from personnel and the entire agency to ensure the highest standard of operations.

Chief Frisbee, Administrative Police Services Manager Gwen Dack, and Accreditation & CSO Program Lead Jennifer Vallejo Rollins were recognized for this achievement during IACLEA's Annual Conference & Exposition in June.
